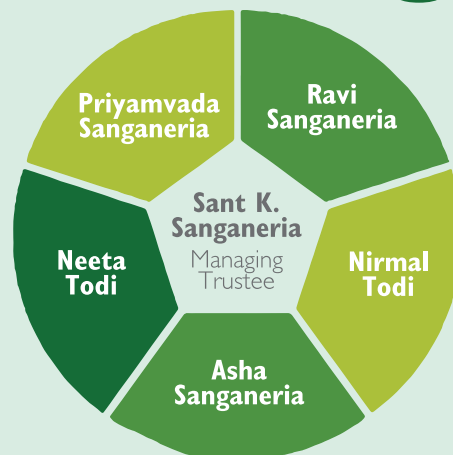

non-profit organisations that actively engage youth and volunteers in projects that provide measurable benefit to the backward community as well as the environment.



Our Projects

Small acts of courage and conviction, can transform our world in big ways.

At SFHE, we work with some of the most vulnerable and relegated communities across India, with an intention to integrate them into the mainstream development process of our country. Our efforts are focussed on several domains with a clear mandate for each.

Power Of Education

At the heart of Sanganeria Foundation is an unflinching desire to ignite the flame of education at the very grassroots of India. That, we believe, will enable the growth of our nation into educated and learned communities. To that effect, we have undertaken the following projects in the education sector:



Sanganeria Science Block consisting of Physics, Chemistry, Zoology and Botany at Hindu College, University of Delhi with financial aid to the tune of Rs.2.05 crores.

Financial support for Shree Raghunath Balika Vidyalaya, Lachhmangarh, Rajasthan since September 2006 to run their daily expenses. An annual cash award and scholarship have also been instituted to encourage students.
